			Has God ordered my steps, and what can I potentially lose if this opportunity doesn't work out?
			How much commitment is required, and is this opportunity worth the time?
			Can I use this opportunity as leverage? Does this opportunity leverage my God-given talents and strengths?
			Do I have the resources (faith + works) to successfully execute this opportunity?
			Does it align with God's word?
			Will this opportunity be a distraction to my short-term and long-term goals?
			Is there any other information I need to know about this opportunity?

Review this list when presented with a possible opportunity. If you answered 'maybe', take time to pray and hear from God before making a decision. Whether it's a networking, career, or business opportunity, these ten questions will help guide you to see if the offer aligns with the call of God for your life.
